In the event of a serious emergency, are they restricted to a bronze level command response or can they take the next step in terms of decisionmaking, liaison and control?

Course Overview

IFTC is launching an ICL 3 course targeted at airport fire service personnel to ensure you have access to the skills, knowledge and confidence to respond effectively when things go wrong.

Using the airport environment as an operating context, this course aims are to enable your incident commanders to:

- Understand the principles of decision-making when leading, monitoring and supporting people to resolve operational incidents
- Understand a tactical approach to leading monitoring and supporting people to resolve operational incidents
- Understand the principles of risk management when leading, monitoring and supporting people to resolve operational incidents
- Understand the principles of debriefing following an operational incident
- Be able to evaluate the status of an operational incident
- Be able to assume responsibility for action to support those involved in an operational incident
- Be able to close down the operational phase in an incident
- Understand collaboration in resolving major incidents
- Undertake the role of Operational ("Silver") Commander at serious multi-agency incidents
